As the runners go past your home we hope that you will be able to come out and cheer them on.

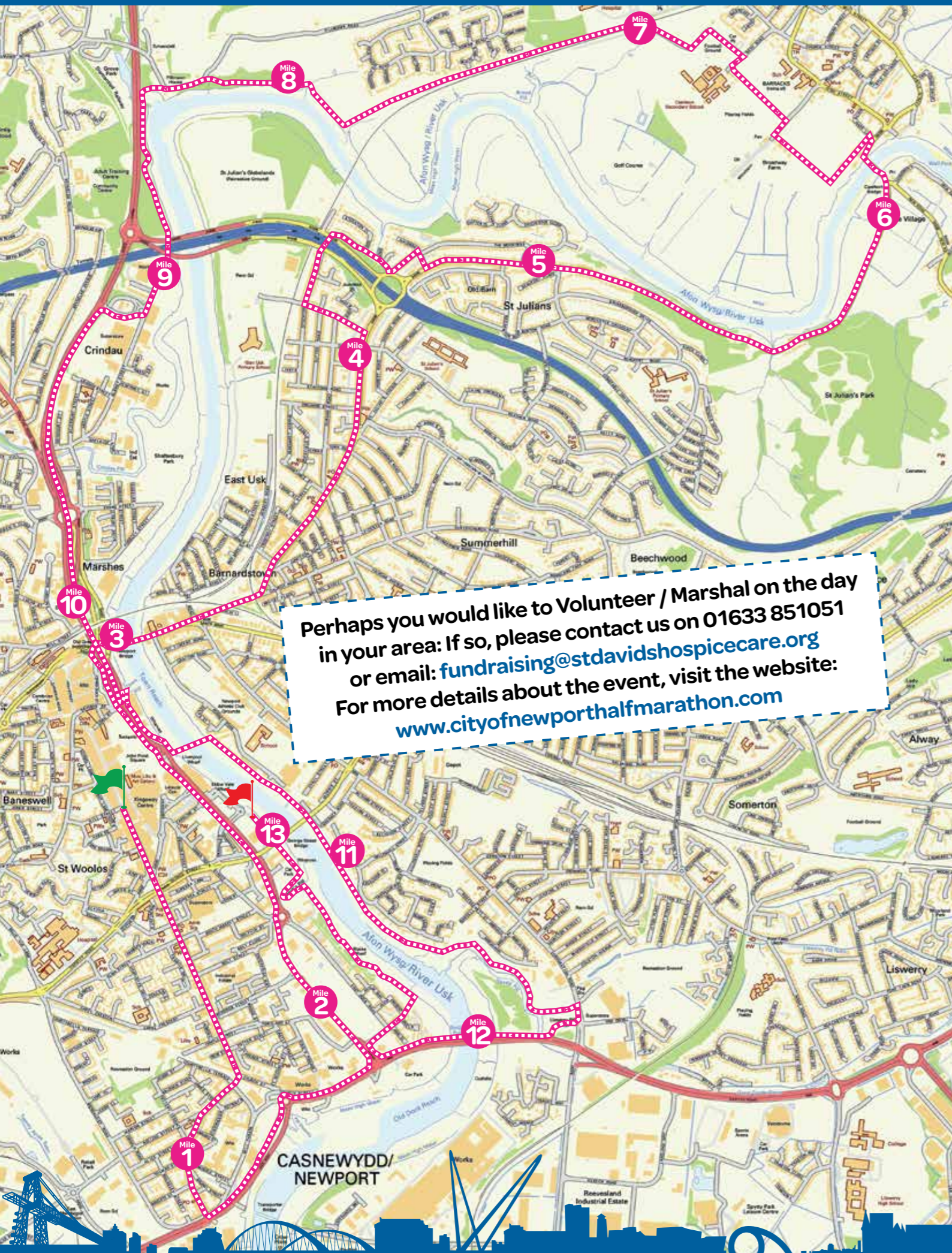

### Road Closures

On race day, road closures and/or restrictions will be in action in the following areas from around 6.00am. Access will still be given to motorists while the set-up is in progress until a complete closure at 8am. The race starts at 9am – and once the last runner has passed your area, the restrictions will be removed.

### Planned closures and/or Stop-Go controls will be in place on the following roads:

- **NO access** onto Commercial Road
- **NO access** onto Alexandra Road
- **NO access/exit** to inside lane on SDR
- **NO access/exit** to inside lane on Usk Way
- **NO access/exit** to inside lane on North Bound Usk Way, **or any road feeding** off it.
- **NO access/exit** travelling north towards Caerleon on Clarence Place or Caerleon Road, **or any road feeding** into/off it.
