As the runners go past your home we hope that you will be able to come out and cheer them on.













On race day, road closures and/or restrictions will be in action in the following areas from around 6.00am, Access will still be given to motorists while the set-up is in progress until a complete closure at 8am. The race starts at 9am – and once the last runner has passed your area, the restrictions will be removed.
